He has published poetry in anthology chapbooks in California and Alaska. Currently he works a day job to pay the bills, but slaves away as a freelancer at night, writing for local businesses and publications like *Lavender Magazine* in the hopes of someday writing for a living. He shares his life in Minneapolis with his extremely supportive, smart, talented and handsome partner, Jonah.



Raymond Luczak is the author of four books and editor of two collections, most notably *Eyes of Desire: a Deaf Gay & Lesbian Reader* (Alyson, 1993), which won two Lambda Literary nominations. His forthcoming deaf gay epic *Men with Their Hands* won a first-place grant from the Arch and Bruce Brown Foundation (excerpts have appeared in many periodicals, including *BLOOM*) and a first-place award in the Project: QueerLit 2006 Contest, which Suspect Thoughts Press will publish. He won an Artist Recognition Grant from the Jerome Foundation VSA Arts, and 13 of his plays have been produced, one in London. His website is www.raymondluczak.com.
